

EATRIS' FLAGSHIP PROJECT FOR SUSTAINABILITY AND PERSONALISED MEDICINE (EATRIS-PLUS) IS GRANTED BY THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION

The EATRIS-Plus project proposal under the H2020-INFRADEV-3 competition coordinated by EATRIS-ERIC was funded by the European Commission. The project is the first submitted with the participation of Bulgaria in the international consortium of EATRIS-ERIC, and Bulgaria is represented by Sofia University "St. Kliment Ohridski" - Faculty of Biology. EATRIS-PLUS aims at sustainable development of the research infrastructure in the field of personalized medicine. The project provides targeted support for capacity building for translational medicine in Bulgaria through exchange and training of young and experienced researchers, development and implementation of good practices in integrated use of molecular omics- technologies for personalized prevention, diagnosis and treatment, optimization of experimental and analytical strategies, stimulation of the expertise of young scientists to profile biomarkers for human research.
